“Welcome to Medicare” Visit

If you are a Medicare beneficiary over the age of 65, you are eligible for a no-cost “Welcome to Medicare” preventive visit. The visit must take place within the first 12 months you have Part B. This visit is covered one time.

During the visit, you and your healthcare provider will discuss your current medical condition, any chronic health problems, your medical history, and any medication or supplements you are taking.

This visit includes:

- Height, weight and blood pressure measurements
- Calculation of your body mass index
- Review of your potential risk for depression
- A vision test
- Review of safety and fall risks
- A discussion about advance directives

In addition, a plan will be developed letting you know which screenings, shots and other preventive services you need.

Yearly “Wellness” Visits

As a Medicare beneficiary, you are also entitled to receive yearly “Wellness” visits. These visits begin after you’ve had Part B for longer than 12 months.

During these visits, you will meet with one of our Medicare Wellness nursing staff to review your current health status.

If warranted, your medical provider may recommend that additional tests or services be performed, either during your visit or at a later date. This may involve lab work, a colonoscopy, imaging services, or other medical services.



Why are your Medicare Wellness visits important?

These annual examinations provide you with healthcare that may lower the risk of illness or injury and allow you to enjoy your daily activities.

Be Prepared for Your Visit

To make your Medicare Visit go as smooth as possible, please ensure you bring the following information to your appointment:

- Current medications (prescription and over-the-counter)
- List of allergies
- Family medical history
- Medical and surgical history
- List of specialists you have seen
- Advanced directives
- Current immunizations

Your Costs

You pay nothing for the “Welcome to Medicare” preventive visit or yearly “Wellness” visits. However, you may have to pay coinsurance and the Part B deductible may apply if additional tests or services are performed either during your visit or at a later date. Discuss any potential out-of-pocket costs with your provider.
