Knoxville Hospital & Clinics (KHC) offers a comprehensive cancer program from early detection to treatment to surgery and more.

Early Detection and Prevention

Cancer screenings and other tests find cancer early, when chances for successfully treating the disease are greatest. Common procedures include:

- Colorectal cancer screening exam (colonoscopy)
- Clinical breast exam
- Digital mammography
- Clinical pelvic exam and pap test
- Human papillomavirus (HPV) testing and vaccine
- Skin cancer screening exam
- Prostate cancer screening exams
- Low-dose computed tomography (LDCT) for lung cancer detection
- Biopsy and diagnostic pathology
- Diagnostic imaging (MRI, CT, Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine)
- Laboratory tests

Chemotherapy & Infusion Center

Our center is staffed by nurses who have specialized training in administering chemotherapy and other infusion treatments.

- Pre-medications (e.g., anti-nausea, anti-inflammatory)
- Chemotherapy medications
- IV antibiotic therapy
- IV immune globulin
- Hydration therapy
- Anti-rejection medication
- Transfusion of blood products
- Procuring specimens for lab testing

Surgery

Surgery-related services include:

- Surgical removal of cancer tumor/cells
- Reconstructive surgery/plastic surgery
- Pain management injection therapy
- Post-surgical hospital care

Ancillary Services and Support

- Nutritional counseling and support
- Financial Assistance Program counseling
- Case management
- Hospice (hospitalized end-of-life care)
- Physical/occupational therapy (Lymphedema treatment)
- Wound care (post-surgical/radiation-related care)
- Interpreter services

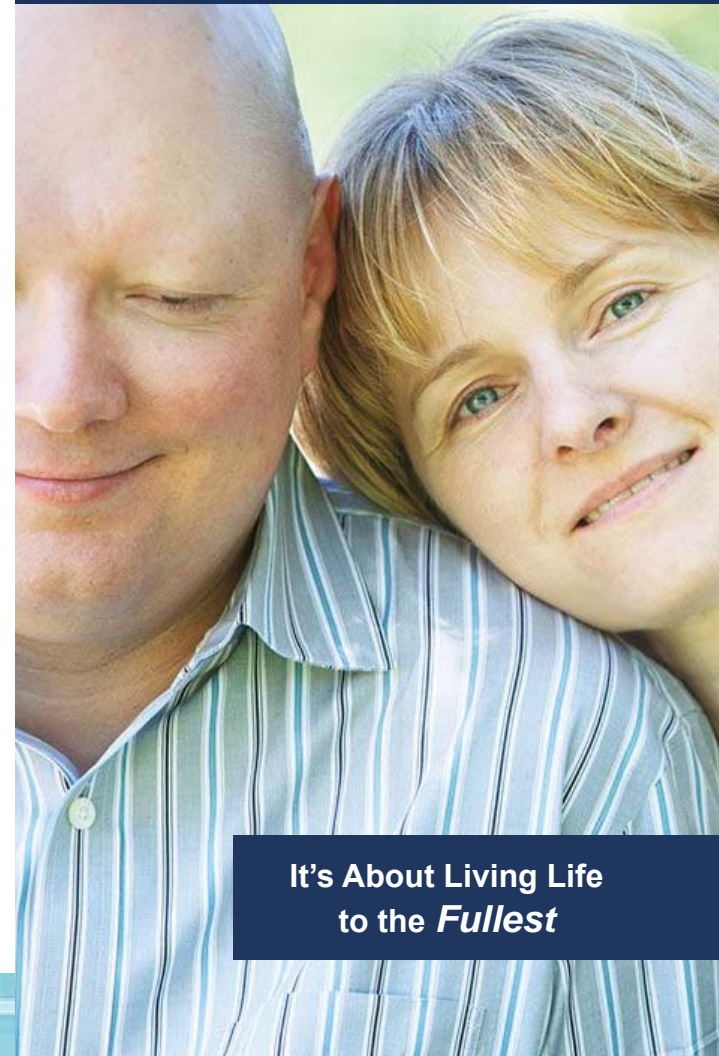

The Cancer Risk



Males: 1 in 3 males will develop cancer. Prostate cancer is the most common type for men. The risk of dying from cancer is 1 in 5.



Females: 1 in 3 females will develop cancer. Breast cancer is the most common type for women. The risk of dying from cancer is 1 in 5.

Some types of cancer run in certain families, but most cancers are not clearly linked to the genes we inherit from our parents. The most common causes of cancer have been linked to smoking and tobacco, diet, physical activity, sun and other types of radiation, workplace or household exposure to carcinogens, viruses, and other infections.

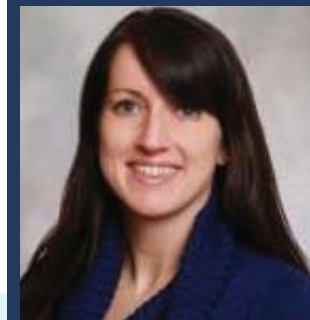
