

Our services

The types of care you will receive are related to the condition to which you were treated during your hospital stay.

Services may include:

- Skilled nursing care
- Nutrition counseling
- Skilled therapy services (physical, occupational, speech/language)
- Complex wound care
- Intravenous or intramuscular injections and intravenous feeding
- Case management
- Prescription medications
- Certain medical supplies and equipment

Services are provided with the expectation that you can improve within a reasonable and generally predictable time-frame and transition to home or another level of care.



Eligibility and insurance coverage

To be eligible for services, your doctor must order skilled nursing care, and you must meet criteria by your insurance company.

KHC is a Medicare-certified skilled nursing facility. Medicare will pay 100% of the Medicare-approved cost for your first 20 days. On days 21 to 100, you are responsible for a daily co-payment, and Medicare pays the rest of covered costs. On days 101 and beyond, you are responsible for all costs.
